The 3rd International Academic Conference on Human Security aims at bringing together leading academics, researchers and practitioners to exchange and share their experiences and research results about all aspects of international migration and human security, as well as global and local health challenges, natural and other disasters, urban violence in public spaces and sustainable human development.

It is organized by the Human Security Research Center (Faculty of Security Studies, University of Belgrade). The previous two editions of the Conference were held in 2004 and 2014. In future, the Conference will become a biannual event which will contribute to scientific development of Human Security.
